■ CCSP® EXAMINATION

Upon successful completion of 100 hours of this program, the doctor is eligible to sit for the certifying examination of the American Chiropractic Board of Sports Physicians™ (ACBSP™). All Candidates for the CCSP® examination are required to obtain the CPR certification on their own (Level C, for Health Professions). In order to sit for this examination, a candidate must bring a current CPR certificate card to the test site.

■ DACBSP™ EXAMINATION

Upon successful completion of 300 hours, the doctor is eligible to sit for the Diplomate (DACBSP™) program examination.

NOTE: The NUHS proficiency examination is separate from the CCSP examination.
